<b>1</b>	< 0.25	15-25	Some localized utility interruptions possible, typically lasting only 1 or 2 hours maximum.

<b>2</b>	< 0.25	$\geq 25$	Scattered utility interruptions expected, typically lasting less than 8-12 hours maximum.

	0.50-1.00	< 15	
<b>3</b>	0.25-0.50	$\geq 25$	Numerous utility interruptions, with some damage to main feeder lines expected with outages lasting from 1-3 days.
	0.50-0.75	15-25

<b>4</b>	0.50-0.75	$\geq 25$	Prolonged & widespread utility interruptions, with extensive damage to main distribution feeder lines and possibly some high voltage transmission lines. Outages expected to last more than 3 to 5 days.

<b>5</b>	0.75-1.00	$\geq 25$	Catastrophic damage to entire utility systems. Outages could last from one week to several weeks in some areas.
